Explanatory notes:

1. The French School of Sydney follows the school calendar of the Northern Hemisphere, which means the school year starts in August and finishes in June.
2. Participation in national literacy and numeracy testing of all students in Years 3, 5 and 7 is compulsory under Australian Commonwealth legislation. It must take place in August each year, which means that by the time they sit for their tests, the students of Lycée Condorcet, because it follows the Northern Hemisphere school year, would have been in their respective classes for a few weeks only following their 6-weeks vacation.
